The Grapevine Family & Community Resource Center, Healthy Starts at HCS, Rise for baby and family, and The River Center are all part of the Monadnock Home Visiting Alliance (MHVA), which promotes the benefits of home visiting for families around the Monadnock region. MHVA is an initiative of Monadnock United Way/Impact Monadnock. The vision of MHVA is that all families with children prenatal to age 5 in the Monadnock region have access to high-quality home visiting services that support parenting and child development.

Support for children with possible or confirmed developmental delays. No income eligibility requirements. Serves the Monadnock region.
